MEMORANDUM FOR U.S. Army Cadet Corps and U.S. Army Personnel

SUBJECT: NCTC Policy #005 – Headgear on the National Cadet Training Center

1. References.

a. AR 670-1, Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia.

b. ACR 670-1, Wear and Appearance of U.S. Army Cadet Corps Army Uniforms and Insignia.

2. Purpose. To provide guidance regarding the wear of headgear on the National Cadet Training Center (NCTC) by United States Army Cadet Corps (USAC) and U.S. Army (USA) personnel.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to USAC and USA personnel attached to the NCTC as either permanent party or in Temporary Duty (TDY) status.

4. Policy.


a. The patrol cap will be worn as the standard headgear on the NCTC, except during graduations or other formations when the beret is prescribed

b. The Drill Sergeant Hat (“Brown Round”) will be worn by Drill Sergeants who have graduated from Drill Sergeant School and are actively engaged in drill sergeant duties. The Pith Helmet will be worn by Cadet Troop Handlers who have graduated from the Troop Handler Academy and are actively engaged in Troop Handler duties. The Black Hat may be worn by officers, when prescribed by the Training Battalion Commander.

c. Officers, noncommissioned officers and Cadets will wear a beret when off-post, except when traveling to a range (rappel tower, FTX site, etc.), when the patrol cap will be worn. Recruits will wear the patrol cap when off-post at any time. The Drill Sergeant Hat and Pith Helmet will not be worn off-post., except when at a range.

SUBJECT: Headgear on the National Cadet Training Center

5. Action. The above policy is effective 1 September 2010.
