## Army Jazz Band to Perform at Millersburg Military Ball



**HEADQUARTERS, U.S. ARMY CADET CORPS** – The U.S. Army Jazz Band – *The Dragoons* from Fort Knox, Ky. – will be the entertainment for the first Millersburg Military Ball to be held on Friday evening, April 24<sup>th</sup>. A gourmet dinner will be followed by dancing and an evening of celebration and reminiscing. Further, historic items from the 113 year history of MMI will be on display.

The Ball, which is open to the public, will celebrate the history of Millersburg Military Institute (MMI) and the future of the U.S. Army Cadet Corps (USAC), which purchased the historic campus in September, 2009.

Additionally, the largest parade in the history of Millersburg – with 37 units registered thus far – will be held on the morning of April 25<sup>th</sup>, followed by the formal Activation Ceremony for the NCTC.
