## U.S. Army Cadet Corps Opens Gym on Tuesday Nights



**HEADQUARTERS, U.S. ARMY CADET CORPS** – The U.S. Army Cadet Corps (USAC) National Cadet Training Center (NCTC) will be opening its gymnasium to young people age 12-16 on Tuesday evenings beginning January 20<sup>th</sup>. The gym will open from 6 to 9 pm and admission will be free. The NCTC is located at 1122 Main Street, Millersburg, Ky, on the historic campus of Millersburg Military Institute (MMI).

A parent or guardian must be present during the student’s first visit in order to sign a liability release form. USAC personnel will also be available to provide details regarding the USAC program, for those who are interested.

A variety of activities will be available, including basketball, pool, foosball and more. Enrolled Cadets will be provided lessons in TACMAP, the Army Cadets Martial Arts Program.

“We are extremely pleased to offer our gymnasium to local young people ...” said Colonel Joseph M. Land, Sr., the corps’ Chief of Staff. “...and we look forward to meeting our neighbors from throughout the community.”

USAC is an Army-oriented career exploration program for young men and women age 12-18 who are crime-free, drug-free and doing well in school. Cadets train one weekend each month, and attend two or more weeks of challenging training each summer. Millersburg is the home of USAC’s summer training programs, hosting several hundred Cadets beginning this summer.
